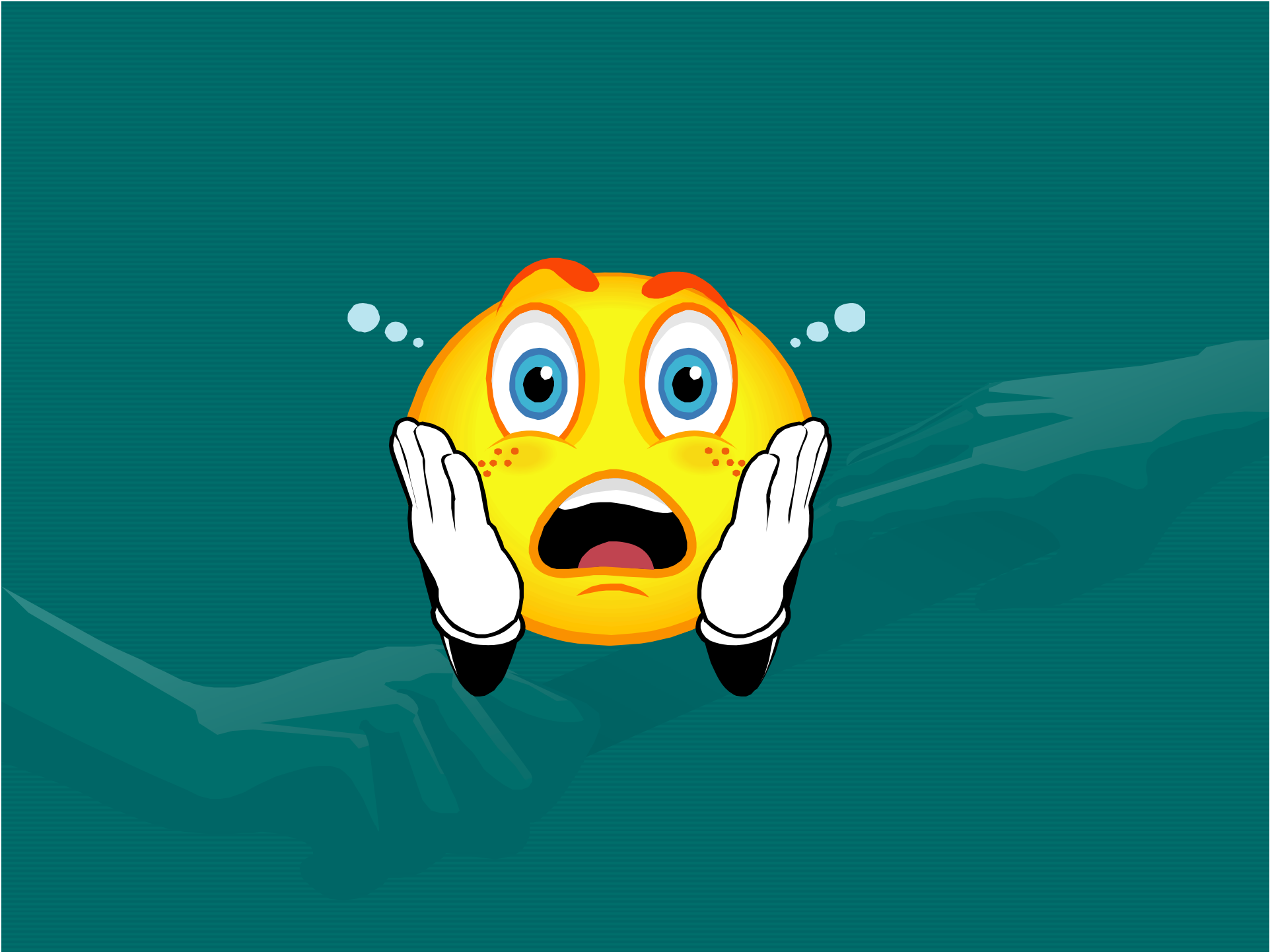




Physician's Assistant Pilot
